reg.**


Sir,

I am directed to refer to your letter dated 23/01/2015 on the above mentioned subject and to say that according to Section 30 of the Copyright Act, 1957, the owners of Copyright are well within their rights to grant any interest in the right by license in writing by them or by their duly authorised agent in any existing work or in any future work as the prospective owner of the copyright.

2. Further, according to Section 33 (1) of the aforesaid Act, an owner of copyright shall, in his individual capacity, continue to have the right to grant licenses in respect of his own works consistent with his obligations as a member of the registered Copyright Society.

3. You may take note of the above legal position for your information and record.
